- Dogs may not be allowed to bark excessively.

BUYER BEWARE:

Also, you should assure yourself that the organization they represent is legitimate.

ECONOMIC STIMULUS CHECKS:

Congressman Ruppertsberger wants to remind everyone that most Americans applied for the stimulus check when they filed their taxes on or before April 15 2008.

Thousands of Americans who do not usually file tax returns are also eligible for the rebate checks. Seniors who receive Social Security payments, disabled veterans, low-income workers and other individuals can qualify for a rebate if they file the proper paperwork before October 15, 2008.
